

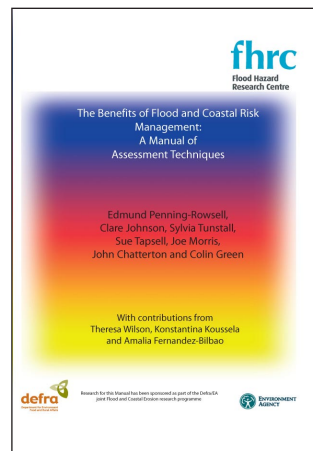
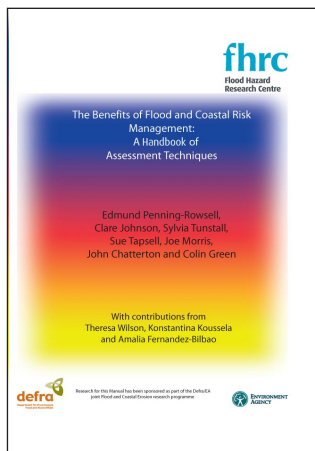

The **Handbook** provides readers with:

- Easier access to the techniques and information needed to undertake evaluation of the benefits for most straightforward risk management projects (probably 75% to 85% of all cases).
- A greater understanding of the principle that for most cases appraisal effort should be proportional to the scale and scope of the decisions required.
- Techniques that fully support sustainable development principles.

The **Manual** provides readers with:

- Access to the rationale and background on the appraisal techniques, with links to the practical methods presented in the Handbook.
- A single appraisal compendium of research by the FHRC, covering the past decade, with updates to concepts introduced in the Centre's previous Manuals, and reporting on most recent research arising from 'The Roadtesting Project'.
- Approaches that support sustainable development.

The Benefits of Flood and Coastal Risk Management provides approaches to implementing the policies set out in the HM Treasury 'Green Book' (HM Treasury, 2003) and Defra Flood and Coastal Management project appraisal guidance (the FCDPAG series).
